Brown Bag Ministry Service Project
Saturday, March 4, 2017 – Lunches for the Homeless

The Wildcat Service Club has chosen to participate in a service project with a local mission called the Brown Bag Ministry, located in Apex.

Below are the details:

Who: Wildcat Service Club members, Clara Stiers, Ricki Lynch and other faculty members.

What: The Brown Bag Ministry's (BBM) mission is to provide food and basic necessities to those in need in our area. BBM has asked groups to donate baby items during the month of March (diapers, wipes, clothing, etc.). On March 4, the club members will be riding the activity bus to Apex to make and pack lunches and then we will go to downtown Raleigh to distribute the lunches to the needy.

Where: St. Andrew the Apostle Church in Apex and Oak City Outreach Center in Raleigh

When: 1) Baby items – Deadline March 1 – Club members may bring donated baby items to the service club meeting on March 1.

2) Distribution of Lunches to Homeless: Saturday, March 4, 2017 from 8:45 am – 1:30 pm - We will meet at 8:45am at WLMS. The activity bus will transport us to St. Andrew the Apostle Church in Apex, to downtown Raleigh, and back to WLMS. We will arrive back at WLMS at around 1:30. Students should be picked up at 1:30 pm at WLMS.

Transportation: Students will be transported by the WLMS activity bus to and from all parts of this trip. Parents pick up at 1:30 at WLMS.

Cost: There is no cost for this project.

What to Bring on March 4: Students may want to bring a snack to eat on the bus, if desired.

Permission Slips: Students and parents are required to complete the field trip permission slip attached to this form or available on the school website/Wildcat Service Club/Projects tabs. The permission slip is due to Mrs. Stiers by February 24, 2017.
